Introduction

The functions of the Chinese Medicine Board of Australia (the Board) include:

- registering the Chinese medicine practitioners and students
- developing standards, codes and guidelines for the Chinese Medicine profession
- handling notifications, complaints, investigations and disciplinary hearings
- overseeing the assessment of overseas trained practitioners who wish to practise in Australia, and
- approving accreditation standards and accredited courses of study.



Chinese Medicine health practitioners – percentage by principal place of practice




