As an AACMA member and practitioner of Traditional Chinese Medicine for the past twenty years, I am writing to express my concerns in relation to the proposed grandparenting standards, particularly to members with pre-2008 qualifications.

Australian-trained practitioners applying for registration under the national scheme should not be put to a higher grandparenting standard than applied under the Victorian scheme. Furthermore, the list submitted by the AACMA of Australian Chinese Medicine programs deemed adequate for grandparenting purposes should be included on the CMBA list of courses deemed adequate for grandparenting purposes.
