In response to the question on the proposed CPD guideline consultation paper, I am writing to express my opining as following:

The requirement for at least 14 hours of CPD to be completed via formal activities is hard to achieve for practitioner who practices in rural area. From past experience, to achieve 14 hours of CPD, probably need to travel to city two to three times, the cost involved would be too high to justify for small town practitioners. Learning activities should not be limited to the form, as long as we learnt something, therefore 10 hours would be reasonable.

The example of CPD activities are clear to understand but it is helpful if the board or association provide more information in more detail or a platform we can check it any time. For example: How many hours should be count for read "Codes and guideline-Advertising" as the time required is different for different people.
